Dear Mr. Allen,

Your letter of greetings and good cheer reached me on my Birthday. It is nice to know that our efforts in this great work are appreciated by our old friends. It is like receiving time and a half, or even double time for our work, since we have already been paid in full in the satisfaction that comes from seeing hundreds of young folks awakening to the fact that this is an orderly universe and that the strife and suffering endured by millions the world over is as unnecessary as it is cruel.

The War as you no doubt can imagine has set our work back very materially, and even though we offer the best, if not the only solution to the great enigma, nevertheless many people feel there are other matters more essential requiring their time for the present, thus our work is made more difficult.

Finding it more difficult to get as many students with a given amount of effort and money as formerly, we have directed our efforts toward attracting a higher type of student, especially in our Correspondence Course and Home Study Department where we have been directing our appeal to business and professional men and women, with the result that our teachers correcting these papers report a display of a much higher grade of intelligence than formerly.

A recent mailing to Protestant Ministers for instance, resulted in the enrollment of nearly 300 Ministers in the following denominations:

Presbyterian	95
Episcopal	116
Quakers	14
Congregational	65

I do not know to what extent they will follow through, but we have already made several most enthusiastic friends from this group, at any rate it is proving to be a most interesting experience.

You no doubt heard of the death of our good friend Harry Weinberger here in New York, thus they are passing one by one and we feel we must make haste in the filling of our ranks with young and determined Georgists.
