
I have looked into the possibilities of arranging some method through life insurance whereby your possible donor will be able to leave the school the sum of \$5,000, and at the same time be assured of a life income.

Under a special combination of Single Premium life insurance with no medical examination, and a life annuity, The Travelers Insurance Company will pay her if her age is 70, \$122.56 a year, and whenever her death occurs will pay to the beneficiary \$5,000. This requires a Single Premium of \$5,500., the minimum under which this plan would be issued. For the same premium if her age is 65, the same benefits will hold except that the annual life annuity will be \$125.35.

An alternative method which would not guarantee \$5,000. to the school, however, would be for your prospective donor to purchase a Single Premium Instalment Refund annuity in the amount of \$5,000., which would pay her if age 70 \$343.10 a year. If age 65, it would pay her \$308.20 a year. Under this contract, at the death of the annuitant, the difference if any between the Single Premium and the amount paid to the annuitant will be paid to the beneficiary in like instalments until the balance is exhausted.

While these figures do not nearly approach the amount she desires, I believe that it will be practically impossible to do much better under today's market conditions. Thanks a lot for the consideration. I shall be more than glad to cooperate further if you feel there is any service I can render you or the school.
