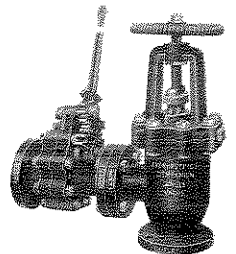
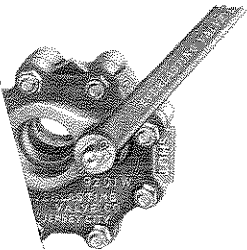
Please let me know as to this. The question can be answered by "yes" or "no".
