SINGLE TAXERS FROM MILK RIVER WILL GO TO CHICAGO

Enthusiasts From Warner Will Also Join Party Leaving October 4

 MILK RIVER, Sept. 28. — Fred Pease, president of the Milk River Single Tax League, advises that arrangements are all complete for the ninth Henry George congress, which will be held in Chicago Oct. 8, 9 and 10.

One of the principle addresses to be delivered will be on the subject of "the cause of unemployment and industrial depression". David Gibson, Cleveland publisher, will deal with this theme.

Other prominent speakers at this congress will include Mayor Wm. N. McNair of Pittsburgh; A. P. Waldauer, assistant city solicitor of Memphis, Tenn.; Clarence Darrow, lawyer of international reputation; Mrs. Anna George Demille of New York; Attorney Charles G. Baldwin of Baltimore and many others who hold the spotlight in public life across the border.

From present indications there will be about 15 delegates from Milk River to the congress, and there will be several more who will accompany the Single Taxers to the Windy City from this district to attend the World's Fair. It is expected there will be four or five from Warner also. The party will leave Milk River on Thursday, Oct. 4.

TABER HAS RECORD BREAKING PULLET
